







Aberdeen Harbour

Code of Safe Practice

-  Maximum speed limit 15mph
-  Never use mobile comms while driving
-  Always obey operational notices
-  Visitors must be accompanied
-  Consider present and forecasted weather conditions
-  Keep your work area tidy
-  Assess risks, plan work and always use safe working practices
-  Always use walkways or pavements where available
-  Never smoke in prohibited areas
-  Keep clear of quay edge
-  Minimum PPE, hard hat, hi-vis clothing and safety footwear
-  Always use fullest precautions when working at height

HOUSEKEEPING

- All debris and potentially hazardous material should be removed from work areas.

PPE

- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) appropriate to the risk assessment must be worn at all times.
- Minimum requirement – hard hat, hi-vis clothing and safety footwear.
- Flotation aids should be worn when working beside or over water and on floating plant or craft.

TRAFFIC

- All traffic should keep to the left and avoid transiting through operational work areas.
- The harbour speed limit is 15mph.
- Drivers are advised to keep a safe distance of at least 2 metres from the quay edge.
