

Marine Consultation Notice

Aberdeen Harbour North Pier Head Light IN 3252 Consultation

The navigation aid at the Head of the North Pier is currently a White and Red sectored occulting light with a nominal range of 9 miles.

It has been suggested that, in order to increase its visibility against background clutter, this light be changed to a GREEN Isophase light, having the same range.

It is also proposed that the RED sector be discontinued, since it seems to serve little practical purpose.

Your views on these changes are sought, and in particular your answers to these questions;

1, Do you agree that the light colour and characteristic should be changed to GREEN Isophase?

If you do not then what would your preference be?

2, Do you agree that the light range should be retained at 9 miles?

If you do not, then what range do you suggest?

3, Is the RED sector a valuable aid to navigation that should be retained?

If you believe that it should, then:

Should its current sector be retained, or should it be something else?
